THE TOLES HIGHER EXAMINATION

TOLES Higher is the second level of the TOLES series of examinations in legal English. The TOLES series consists of three specialist examinations designed to measure a candidate's skills in legal English. There are four grade bands at higher level. Candidates' results are expressed as a percentage score.

A score that falls within the two top bands of the TOLES Higher examination can indicate stronger *legal* English skills than a more advanced certificate from a general English examination.

- **81 100** This candidate is assessed as having **EXCELLENT** legal English skills at intermediate level. This candidate:
 - can deal confidently and ably with all of the examination requirements listed in the syllabus
 - is competent to deal with written or spoken legal English at intermediate level and has strong strategies for coping with new language
 - can deal unaided with certain authentic documents and carefully conducted conference situations or telephone conversations
 - is ready to progress to the TOLES Advanced examination
- **61 80** This candidate is assessed as having **GOOD** legal English skills at intermediate level. This candidate:
 - can deal well with many of the examination requirements listed in the syllabus and would be even stronger with further practice
 - has made excellent progress in dealing with written or spoken legal English at intermediate level
 - is close to being able to deal unaided with certain authentic documents and has a strong understanding of language used in conference situations or in telephone conversations.
 - is almost ready to progress to the TOLES Advanced examination
- **41 60** This candidate is assessed as having **SATISFACTORY** legal English skills at intermediate level. This candidate:
 - is challenged by the examination requirements listed in the syllabus but is well on the way to reaching intermediate level skills.
 - has a fundamental understanding of written and spoken legal English at intermediate level and will continue to improve with practice
 - has some understanding of certain authentic legal documents and the language used in conference situations or telephone conversations but continues to require support
 - requires further study at intermediate level before progressing to the TOLES
 Advanced examination
- **0 40** This candidate **DOES NOT YET POSSESS** the legal English skills necessary for intermediate level. This candidate:
 - can deal with some of the examination requirements listed in the syllabus but is weak in some or all key areas
 - has a below average understanding of written and/or spoken legal English at intermediate level
 - requires considerable support when dealing with authentic legal documents and the language used in conference situations
 - requires considerable further study at intermediate level before progressing to the TOLES Advanced examination
